NOTICE INVITING E TENDER FOR PROCUREMENT OF **GENERAL DRUGS** and **DRESSING MATERIALS** FOR THE YEAR 2015-2016 BY THE ADDITIONAL DIRECTOR GENERAL AND INSPECTOR GENERAL OF CORRECTIONAL SERVICES, WB.

(Through Pre-qualification)
(Submission of Bid through *NIC e tender portal*)

The ADG & IG of Correctional Services, WB having its office at Directorate of Correctional Services, WB, Jessop Building, 63, N. S. Road, Kolkata-700001 is going for e-tender for and on behalf of the Governor of West Bengal for preparing of Rate Schedule of **General Drugs and Dressing materials** for the year 2015-16, till 31.03.2016, and its extension, if required for a further period of 6 (Six) months from the **manufacturers and distributors**(of scheduled companies) of medicines, for supply to the following Correctional Homes:

Central Correctional Homes:	Presidency, Alipore, DumDum, Midnapore, Berhampore and Jalpaiguri
Special Correctional Home:	Siliguri
District Correctional Home:	Krishnanagar and Malda

Necessary earnest money to be submitted for participation in the Tender through Demand Draft is **Rs. 1.00 (one) lakh** per tenderer payable in favour of ADG & IG of Correctional Services, WB. No interest will be paid for the earnest money deposit.

1. General Instructions:

In the event of e-filing, intending bidder may download the tender documents free of cost from the website: <http://wbtenders.gov.in> directly with the help of Digital Signature Certificate or from the Directorate of Correctional Services, WB website www.wbcorrectionalservices.gov.in or www.banglarmukh.gov.in & necessary earnest money may be remitted to the office of the Directorate of Correctional Services, WB through Demand Draft issued from any nationalized bank/scheduled bank in India payable at Kolkata drawn in favour of ADG & IG of Correctional Services, WB, Kolkata and also to be documented through e-filing.

2. Submission of bids:

Both Technical bid and Financial Bid are to be submitted concurrently duly digitally signed by the **Company personnel only (having Authorization from the company management)** in the website <http://wbtenders.gov.in>. All papers must be submitted in English language with **Page Marking**.

3. Time Schedules for the e-tender: THE TIME SCHEDULE FOR OBTAINING THE BID DOCUMENTS, REGISTRATION WITH THE TENDERING AUTHORITIES, THE SUBMISSION OF BIDS AND OTHER DOCUMENTS ETC. WILL BE AS PER THE LIST PROVIDED IN CLAUSE NO 28 GIVEN BELOW.

4. ELIGIBILITY FOR SUBMITTING QUOTATION:

Manufacturers and/or distributors (of scheduled companies as at annexure I) who are able to supply the assured quantities as per requirement of **the Correctional Homes** & have requisite Annual Average Turnover, as per clause no. 5, are only eligible for quoting. Manufacturers /distributors not having the capability to supply the full assured quantity solely need not apply. Factory inspection would follow for determining manufacturing capacity, status of production & confirmation of full assured supply for those vendors having L1 status to take final decision about determination of L1. In the event of being L1 for such cases for more than one item, commitment or declaration about part assured supply will not be entertained and the offer will stand rejected.

The vendors who were declared L1 but did not execute agreement or did not supply even after execution of agreement in the tender, 2014-15 floated by Directorate of Correctional Services, WB and/or declared black listed or debarred from participation in tender are not eligible to participate in the current tender.

The Vendors who have been black listed by any Govt. Concern/health Institutions in the Country for particular item(s) are also not eligible to apply.

5. ANNUAL TURNOVER REQUIREMENTS:

Principal Manufacturer/Distributor (of the scheduled companies at annexure I), whose average annual Turn Over for last three financial years is more than **Rs. 50 (Fifty) lakh** totaling **1.5 (One and a half) crore** for the last three years and S.S.Is registered in West Bengal whose average annual Turn Over for last three financial years is more than **Rs. 5 (Five) lakh** totaling **15 (Fifteen) lakh** for the last three years, are only eligible to participate in the Tender.

6. SUBMISSION OF THE TENDERS:

The tender is to be submitted in a two Bid System. The approved Bidders of the General Tender (Drugs) 2014-15 should have to submit all the technical/financial documents afresh.

TECHNICAL BID: To be uploaded in the e-portal and also to be submitted physically.

STATUTORY COVER containing the following documents:

All the documents enclosed in the Technical Bid must be signed by the competent authority, page-marked and submitted into the box earmarked as “Tender Box for Technical Bid” alongwith the original Bank Draft for Earnest Money, at the office of the Directorate of Correctional Services, WB within the stipulated date.

FINANCIAL BID: BOQ

The folder as “**FINANCIAL BID**” shall contain:

Rate per unit/ml repeat per unit/ml inclusive of Entry Tax, Customs Duty (if applicable), Transportation Charges, Insurance, Delivery Charges, Incidental Charges, Freight Charges, Testing Charges etc. and inclusive of VAT / CST, Excise duty and Cess (wherever applicable) etc.

No other charges can be levied over and above the rate quoted in the BOQ.

LOAN LICENCE- No drug manufactured under a Loan License/third party manufacturer shall be offered by a tenderer.

7. The tenderers are required to submit the hard copies of the Technical Bid as per schedule more clearly described in the time line vide clause 28 along with Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) in separate packets. Submission of hard copy of Technical Bid to the office of the Directorate of Correctional Services, WB is for reference only while examining the technical bid on line and will not be treated as substitute for on line submission. Submission of hard copy of Financial Bid is totally prohibited and only be submitted through on line through NIC portal. **Attested and page-marked Financial Bids of only the successful tenderers will be required to be submitted after completion of the selection process.**

8. Evaluation of the tenders

During the tender evaluation process, the Technical Bid will be opened first and Financial Bid will be opened subsequently. Those Bidders who have qualified in respect of the essential & other requirements will be identified and their financial bid will be opened after further physical verification of the documents enclosed under Technical Bid. The financial bid of those Tenderers failing to meet the technical & other requirements of participating in the tender will not be opened and be rejected. The Tenderer offering the item found suitable and as per the tender specifications will only be selected. Final selection of the lowest bidders in respect of Financial Bid is subject to further verification.

The manufacturing/ supply capability of the Tenderer and assured timely delivery to the Correctional Homes of West Bengal will be assessed by the ADG & IG of Correctional Services,

WB and the manufacturer/distributor capable to supply the assured quantity as per the requirements of the **drug procuring Correctional homes** to the items for which he has quoted will also be identified and assessed before opening of financial bid.

The Tenderer who have been so identified to be technically suitable in the context of above and are having the manufacturing/distributing capability and confirmation about the assured supply requirements of the **drug procuring Correctional homes** as authorized by the Directorate during the tender period and/or have supplied the ordered value made to them (in respect of existing vendors) will be deemed to have passed the test of essential and other requirement of the quoted item or items.

The (Financial Bids) of only these tenderers passing the essential and other requirement test will then be opened subject to verification of hard copies of the audited balance sheet and Profit & Loss Accounts of the tenderer for the last three years i.e. for the year 2011-12 , 2012-13 & 2013-14 and other documents.

If found suitable in the context of above pre qualification etc, the Tenderer quoting the lowest rate will be considered as successful. **Factory inspection may follow for determining manufacturing/distributing capacity and confirmation of assured supply to take final decision in this matter for determination of L1.**

For vital and life savings item or items, if the lowest quoting tenderer fails to supply the total requirements of the **drug procuring Correctional Homes** at any stage or in the exigency of the situation, counter offers shall be invited from the next higher bidder i.e. L2, L3 and L4 etc to supply at the lowest rate, i.e. at L1 rate.

THE DECISION OF THE ADG & IG of Correctional Services, WB and the TENDER SELECTION COMMITTEE WILL BE FINAL AND BINDING IN THIS MATTER.

9. All out of West Bengal State manufacturers must have a bonafide office in West Bengal and a C & F agent possessing valid Drug Licence and Trade Licence issued from the West Bengal State Drug Controlling Authority and Administrative authority respectively. Local (based in West Bengal) SSIs/local PSU/CPSU/local manufacturers are not allowed to engage Distributors for raising bill and receiving payment in the latter's favour.

The matter related to Way Bill is the responsibility of the C&F agent and the procuring authorities will not issue any way bill.

In the event of being selected, the hard copies for under mentioned documents of the company must be submitted by the tenderer to the concerned Superintendents of Correctional Homes of West Bengal as 'TENDERER SUMMARY' before execution of the agreement:

- i. Letter of Authority from the Tenderer (manufacturer) in the letter head of the manufacturer duly signed by the Authorized Signatory of the manufacturer in favour of C& F agent/distributor stating clearly the status of the Agent.
- ii. PAN No. & Last year's Income Tax Return submitted, VAT/ST Registration Certificate & Validity Documents.
- iii. Drugs Licence & its current Renewal Certificate /Validity Certificate, Current Trade Licence. It is, however, made clear that agreement in pursuance of the accepted tenders will be executed only with the Tenderer who will be responsible for the supply.

10. Cost of Earnest Money:

- a. Each tenderer, unless exempted under the existing orders of the West Bengal Govt. must deposit Earnest Money in the form of **Demand Draft** from any Nationalized Bank/Scheduled bank in India for **Rs. 1.00 lakh (Rs. one lakh) only**, irrespective of the number of items quoted, drawn in favour of ADG & IG of Correctional Services, WB.
- b. The earnest money is to be deposited in the prescribed time during opening of Technical Bid. The onus of providing that a Tenderer is exempted from Earnest Money will lie on the Tenderer and must be proved by the submission of valid documents.
- c. The earnest money of the Tenderer will liable to be forfeited if the Tenderer withdraws his tender as a whole or for any particular item at any stage after the opening of the tender, or fails / refuses to enter into written agreement for any or all of the items of his accepted tender within the time specified when requested to do so/fails to furnish Security Deposit within the stipulated time.
- d. The Earnest Money will be refunded after finalization of the tender & execution of agreement with the tenderer against the specific prayer of Tenderer.
- e. The Earnest Money will be refunded to the non-qualified bidders in respect of technical bid against the prayer of the bidder.

11. PREFERENCE & REGULATIONS FOR S.S.I., W.B. & OTHERS AS UNDER NOTED:

Preference will be given to the S.S.I., W.B., P.S.U., W.B. and State Based Other Manufacturers as per West Bengal Financial Rule incorporated under notification No.10500-F dated 19.11.04. Registration as a Small Scale Industries unit after the submission of the tender will not entitle the Tenderer to get exemption from payment of Earnest Money.

12. Schedule M Compliance Certificate/GLP CERTIFICATE:

Only manufacturers having COMPLIANCE of Revised "M"- SCHEDULE (GMP) and preferably with GLP Certificate are eligible to take part in the tender.

13. DRUGS LICENCE:

Certified copy of Drug Licence with current validity certificate along with full list of endorsement/product passing reports with items highlighted by colouring / underlining of items quoted in the tender must be submitted. The items should be Marked / Highlighted with marker pen mentioning there in the CAT/Serial No. for each particular item.

14. B.I.S. CERTIFICATE:

The item(s) which are under I.S.I. specification must have certificate from Bureau of Indian Standard and valid endorsement copies.

15. RATE:

- a. Rates are to be quoted for items as per the list of the Catalogue as provided.
- b. Rate should be quoted in decimal coinage stating the particular item as per Catalogue of the Tender proposed to be supplied inclusive of all incidental charges including FREE DOOR DELIVERY to the drug procuring Correctional Homes of West Bengal, listed above. Sterile items are to be transported in such packaging so that there is no damage to the primary packaging during the transportation process.
- c. Rates quoted in respect of items shall not exceed the controlled price (DPCO) and/ or M.R.P. (maximum retail price) fixed by GOI wherever it is applicable.
- d. Rates shall be valid throughout the period to be covered by the contract to be executed with successful tenderers along with any extensions as may be made by the competent authority from time to time.

e. **THE RATE PER PIECE(UNIT or ml) REPEAT PER PIECE(UNIT or ml)** should be furnished, **inclusive of Entry Tax, Customs Duty (if applicable), Transportation Cost, Insurance, Freight, testing charges, Incidental Charges etc. including of VAT/CST, Excise Duty & Cess etc.,** into the **Bill of Quantities (BOQ).**

16. ORDER & SUPPLY:

I. Orders for the supply of the approved products will be placed with the successful tenderers after the execution of the agreements, in phases as and when required by the procuring Correctional Homes across the State. The successful tenderer will have to supply within the specified time schedule that had been assured as prescribed.

II. All supplies will have to be completed by door delivery within maximum 30 days from the date of order in the fax/e-mail/SMIS System of the procuring Correctional Homes. **NO RELAXATION ON ANY ACCOUNT WILL BE ALLOWED FOR CONDONING DELAYED SUPPLIES.**

III. The permissible time period between the date of manufacture and the date of supply of the items should not be more than 1/6th of the whole life period. No delivery will be taken of any drug if the date of manufacture and the date of expiry are not written on each and every unit supplied.

IV. In case of non-supply/less supply of any item by any approved lowest quoted firm, the Tender Committee can ask for willingness to L2 / L3 / L4 etc firm to supply at L1 rate (lowest approved rate).

17. LABELLING:

All supplies of articles in drugs section should invariably contain the following information on its label and the carton.

Information should not be overlapped by any other information needed to be furnished.

a. Pharmacopoeia name.

b. Manufacturing date.

c. Expiry Date.

d. Name & address of Registered Office of Manufacturers and place of manufacture.

e. Manufacturing Licence Number.

f. Batch Number

g. All Drugs/ Chemicals quoted/ supplied by tenderer MUST CONFORM TO B.P, U.S.P, I.P and N.F.I –III specification. For off and on change of specification like BP., I.P. etc, favourable documents need to be produced to the purchasing authority for acceptance.

h. In respect of IV fluid, the bottle should be manufactured and filled by the “Blow, Fill & Seal in polypropylene 500 ml bottle” and/or “Form Fill & Seal polyethylene 500 ml bottle ” and the bottle meet the pharmacopeia specification. Documentary evidence in support of the quality of the bottle should be furnished at the time of supply.

i. Month and Year of supply.

j. The bottle label & carton should invariably be marked with “For C.HOME Supply. Not for sale”

Note A: “The MRP Rate should not be printed in the Strips, Bottles, Ampoules, and Vials etc.”

Note B: “Any information like Manufacturer’s Name & Address is strictly prohibited to be inscribed/ printed in any part of the wall of the bottle and cork.”

18. MANUFACTURING AND PACKAGING:

a) Packing of medicine (tablets, capsules, solid & liquid preparation), and Lab Chemicals with standard packing materials

1. The rigid PVC used in blister packing should be of not less than 250 micron.
2. All glass bottles should be new neutral glass.
3. Ointments should be packed in liquidized Aluminum Tubes.
4. Small Tablets packed in blisters should be packed to facilitate easy removal of the tablet without breaking / crushing.
5. Tablets should have a score line as per the relevant pharmacopeia norms.
6. All plastic containers should be made of virgin grade plastics.
7. All plastic jars above 450Gms / ml should carry an inner plastic lid.
8. Injection in vials should have a snap off seal.
9. All tablets should be in aluminum strips or blisters with Aluminum foil back. Strips of Aluminum foils refer to gauge 04. Aluminum foils as back material for blisters refer to gauge 025.
10. Light sensitive drugs are to be in amber coloured bottles
11. Liquids and Drops should be packed with plastic dispensers
12. Glass ampoules should be packed with cutters @ 1 cutter for each 5 ampoules in a separate polybag.
13. ORS should be packed in sachets made of Aluminum Foil laminated with glassing or heat sealable plastic film (multiple laminations with Aluminum foil (polyethylene, Aluminum, polyester)), whose outer paper may contain label information (50 sachets may be packed in gray board boxes and 10 gray board boxes in a corrugated box).
14. For ORS and Halogen tab, shrinkage package should be applied for 50 packets containing 500 tabs respectively.

b) Corrugated package box size limited to (12" H x 24"L x 24"W).

1. No corrugated box with contents should weigh more than 15 kgs (7 kgs in case of ointments and fragile materials)
2. The inner lining shall be not less than 120 gsm and outer carton not less than 150 gsm.
3. The non glass bottle containing cartons shall be of at least 5 ply with bursting strength not less than 9 kg/sq cm
4. Glass bottle containing cartons shall be of at least 7 ply with bursting strength not less than 12 kg/sq cm
5. No box should contain mixed products or mixed batches of the same product.
6. The product label on the cartoon should be large at least 15 cm x 10 cm dimension. It should carry the correct technical name, strength or the product, date of manufacturing, date of expiry, quantity packed and net weight of the box.

19. DRUG TESTING:

(a) The ADG & IG of Correctional Services, WB in consultation with the Tender Selection Committee, as well as the Superintendents of the drug procuring Correctional Homes will be at liberty to get the drugs / chemicals tested at Govt. selected/ empanelled laboratory, including NABL accredited laboratories, the identity of which shall not be divulged to the tenderer. Such testing will be in addition to tests that may be done by any authority exercising statutory powers of drug testing. The tenderer shall be bound to destroy the defective & non-standard batch (es) as per assay and other quality test report under pharmacopeia norms. The tenderer shall be bound to replace the defective batch or batches if found defective as per wrong

packaging or labeling. The cost of procurement of such non-standard drugs or defective batch (es) will not be paid. Moreover, action under relevant Rules of the Drugs and Cosmetic Act will also be taken.

In no circumstances request by the suppliers for replacement of non-standard drugs found defective or sub standard in the quality test will be entertained.

(b) A sum @ 2% of bills exclusive of Govt. tax & duties will be deducted from the bills of the supplies of medicine by the Superintendents of the drug-procuring Correctional Homes to meet cost of random testing charges. The testing charge, however will not be deducted if the batch contain test report from Govt. Laboratory at Kasauli, Himachal Pradesh in respect of ARV, AVS and other sera/vaccines.

(b) Each installment of supply of drugs / chemicals must be accompanied with a **test certificate from a GLP certified laboratory**. The full name and qualification and the attested signature of the certifying chemist is to be submitted in a separate sheet.

(d) The Correctional Homes will depend on testing reports obtained from empanelled laboratory as per norm for non drug item also.

20. WITHDRAWAL /CANCELLATION & PURCHASE POLICY OF TENDERING AUTHORITY:

The tendering authority reserves the right to withdraw any item from the tender at any stage. The selection of such item, if already made in favour of any Tenderer, shall be treated as cancelled.

i) The tendering authority reserves the right to reject or accept any tender or part thereof at any stage or to split any tender without assigning any reason. Withdrawal of tender or any revision after submission of tender by the Tenderer will not be allowed.

ii) The tendering authority reserves the right to accept or reject any tender, in part or in full, without assigning any reason.

iii) Purchase will, however be made following the existing purchase policy of the Govt of West Bengal and its amendment(s) made from time to time. The purchase policy of the State Government as provided in the West Bengal Financial Rules, the policy of price preference in particular incorporated under **Notification No. 10500-F dated 19.11.04 should be observed in considering the tenders.**

iv) The tendering authority reserves the right to purchase any item of the Catalogue at the approved rate from any outsider (Non- Tenderer) during the tender period in case of emergency, if the tenderer fails to supply such items on short notice,

v) The tendering authority reserves the right to procure any item, of the tender directly from a state/ Central Govt. undertaking even if a tender for the same has been offered/ accepted.

21. NO- CONVICTION CERTIFICATE:

No conviction certificate is to be submitted from the **Drug Controlling Authority of the State** where the manufacturer is registered for last three years. He will also submit **an affidavit** in the prescribed Pro-forma attached herewith from Notary/ first class Judicial Magistrate/Executive Magistrate.

22. PENALTY CLAUSES

IT SHOULD BE REALISED BY ALL THE TENDERERS THAT GENERAL AND OTHER DRUGS CONSTITUTE AN IMPORTANT PART OF THE VITAL & ESSENTIAL MEDICINES REQUIRED FOR THE TREATMENT OF INMATE- PATIENTS OF THE CORRECTIONAL HOMES. THIS IS MORE SO IN CASE OF SERIOUS AND

EMERGENCY PATIENTS. THERE CAN BE NO RELAXATION IN THE QUALITY AND TIMELY SUPPLY OF THESE ITEMS UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES, AS THIS WOULD SERIOUSLY & ADVERSELY AFFECT PATIENTS-CARE SERVICES. TENDERERS ARE THEREFORE ADVISED TO CAREFULLY ASSESS THEIR MANUFACTURING ABILITY AND CAPABILITY FOR ENSURING TIMELY SUPPLY TO THE drug procuring CORRECTIONAL HOMES, PRIOR TO PARTICIPATING IN THIS TENDER.

A) In case of **supply of the sub-standard** items found in the quality test as per quality assurance norms, the defective batch /batches determined by the appropriate authority will not be returned to the tenderers for replacement but will be destroyed and the payment of the defective batches will not be made to the supplier or if paid in the meantime, is to be deducted from the pending bills of the tenderer.

B) In case of supply of **defective item found in respect of packaging or labeling**, tenderer will be asked to replace the same.

C) In **addition to rejection of the supply**, the ADG & IG of Correctional Services, WB and the Superintendents of Correctional Homes will have the right to cancel the supply order wholly or in part, to forfeit security deposit and to recover the loss, if any, of the Govt. by making deductions from any pending claim of the supplier/ Security Deposit, as may be deemed fit. Such Penalty for supply of a drug falling within the meaning of adulterated/ spurious/ misbranded under Section 17 (A), 17 (B) and 17 (C) of the Drugs and Cosmetic Act will be in addition to action which may be taken by police, the Drug Control Authority or by tendering authority of the State Govt or the Govt of India or by any individual under the law of the land.

D) Debarment from participation in next tender processes of the Directorate of Correctional Services, WB: The tender selection committee reserves the right to declare a firm/ Company blacklisted for three (03) years due to the following reasons:

If the supplier

i) **Withdraws from agreement** after achieving the “Lowest Quoted Tenderer”

ii) **Failure to supply within stipulated period for three** occasions during the tenure of the tender period or its extensions.

iii) In case of **supply of spurious drugs** (as applicable)/, along with proceedings under the provisions Drugs and Cosmetic Act, 1940 and Rules framed therein.

iv) **Supplying Non – standard items** as per quality test within tender period as determined by the testing of the item as per discretion of Tender Selection Committee in respect of particular items only.

v) In consequence of **submission of false or fabricated documents** by any firm/ company for participating in the tender, if proved later on.

vi) **Quoting absurdly high or low rate** in the opinion of Tender selection Committee, with the intention to vitiate the tender process.

vii) **Supply of items with short expiry dates** in violation of Clause 16 (iii) on more than three occasions.

viii) Submission of tender **during the period of blacklisting** of Concern /Company / its Principals/ or sister concern (where its Principals or Promoters have more than 10% shares) either by Tender Inviting Authority or by any State Government or by other State/Central Government.

The Directorate of Correctional Services, WB will have the right to inspect the manufacturing units of the tenderers before accepting the rates quoted by them or at any point of time during

continuation of the tender and the Tender Committee will also have the right to reject tender or terminate/ cancel the purchase order(s) and/ or not to re- order based on the adverse reports brought during those inspections.

E) Financial Penalties for deficiencies in services/supplies during the period of the tender and its subsequent extensions:

1. For delay in the supply of items ordered beyond the stipulated date. Part supply will not be considered.

a. In respect of all consignment, stipulated period will be 30 (Thirty) days from the date of order generated in SMIS/fax/e-mail. The order generated out of the SMIS will carry the same status that of signed order.

b. If the supplies are not made in full within the stipulated period of placing the order, 0.5% of the bill of the materials not supplied will be deducted from the existing / pending bills of the supplier per day's delay up to 30 days.

c. For delays beyond 30(thirty) days, the work order for the non- supplied portion will be considered as cancelled straightaway.

d. However, if the stipulated period ends on Saturday, Sunday or Govt holidays, supply should be made on the next working day and in that case, no penalty would be chargeable.

e. The provision of penalty cannot be waived in any case.

f. For failure to supply beyond 30 days for three occasions for a particular item for a particular procuring Correctional Home, the firm quoting L2 will be selected after issuance of show cause notice to the concerned vendor.

g. The Firm will be blacklisted after issuance of a Show-Cause letter for such delay beyond 30 days in three occasions.

2. For firms who fail to supply the full order on three occasions within the stipulated time within the tender period and its extensions- **the whole Earnest Money and the Security Deposit will be forfeited** and the firm and its **principals will be debarred** from participation in the tenders **for the next three years.**

3. Supply of items with short expiry dates in violation of Clause 16 (iii) on more than two occasions- 5% of the cost of the items or Rs 10,000, whichever is higher will be deducted from the bills.

4. The names of the defaulting suppliers will be put up in the Departmental website. Enhancement of rates of raw materials etc or the fact that the tender period has been extended will not be acceptable as a plea for not supplying the materials within the stipulated period as provided in the work order.

23. PENALTY FOR FORMATION OF CARTEL OR FURNISHING OF FRADULENT/ MISLEADING DOCUMENTS:

If during the tender process or at any stage during the validity of the tender period, it is found that a Tenderer(s) has formed a cartel in what so ever form or name to fix up the rates or suppliers to the detriment of the fairness of the tender process, penal measures shall be initiated. Similar penal measures shall also be initiated against those tenderers who have submitted false/ misleading/ fraudulent documents or made incorrect declarations.

The penal measure will be

i) Forfeiture of Earnest Money

ii) Forfeiture of Security Deposit if enlisted as a supplier

iii) Cancellation from the approved list of suppliers and debarment from further supply orders

iv) Black listing from all Departmental tenders of the Tenderer, the Principals of the firm(s) and the concerned distributor(s) for a period of three years.

24. AGREEMENT:

On a tender being accepted, intimation of acceptance will be forwarded through departmental website by the ADG & IG of Correctional Services, W.B. After communication of the same, the Tenderer will have to execute agreement in the prescribed form along with submission of requisite amount of Security Deposit to the concerned Superintendents within 15 days from the date of issue of invitation. **A copy of the agreement must be sent to the ADG & IG of CS, WB immediately failing which no indent/store-order made to the company will stand valid.**

25. VALIDITY PERIOD OF AGREEMENT:

The contract period will be for a period up to 31st March 2016 which may be extended up to six months with prior approval of the ADG & IG of Correctional Services, WB if necessary.

26. SECURITY DEPOSIT:

(i) The Security Deposit will be **mandatory for all approved suppliers including SSI units** and will not be waived in any case.

(ii) The successful tenderers shall be required to furnish the security deposit **@ Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand) only per item for every Correctional Home**, for which the Tenderer has been selected as supplier, **in the form of Bank Draft.**

(iii) The Security Deposit from any nationalized/ scheduled bank in India acceptable to the Government of West Bengal should be submitted to the concerned Superintendents within 15 (fifteen) days from the date of acceptance of tender.

(v) If Agreement has not been executed along with submission of Security Deposit within 15 days from the date of acceptance of tender, the candidature will be cancelled and the next Bidder will be accepted.

(vi) The Security Deposit will be liable to forfeiture as enumerated in Clauses **22 & 23** above.

27. INSPECTION:

The competent authority may visit any factory, at any day, at any time in a regular basis for inspection, to adjudge its production capability, and assured supply and take decision accordingly for L1 status.

During the scrutiny, if it comes to the notice to Tender Inviting Authority that the credential or any other paper is incorrect/ manufactured/ fabricated, that bidder would not be allowed to participate in the tender and that application will be out rightly rejected without any prejudice. The onus of the legibility of the documents will solely rest on the bidder.

32. APPEAL:

(a) On the event of any dispute or difference of any kind whatsoever (the decision whereof is not provided for) shall arise between the **Tenderer and the Superintendent of the Correctional Home(s)** out of this tender, it shall be referred to for arbitration by the **A.D.G. & Inspector General of Correctional Services, West Bengal**, who shall have the final authority for decisions to the parties.



2. Disallow the acceptance to any tenderer with regard to one/some/all items despite being L1 for the same without citing any reason thereof.




